

GRAD DINNER and GRADUATION 2018

DATE: Wednesday, June 27th, 2018

GRAD DINNER TIME: 5:00 – 7:00 PM

GRADUATION CERENOMY TIME: 8:00 – 10:00 pm.....see below

AWARDS: If you receive an award, you must notify Mrs. Leisa Brow ASAP, otherwise, we have no way of knowing if you have received the award and it cannot be announced or put in the graduation program.

ARRIVAL TIME: Grad Dinner will be at KMC at 5:00pm. Students will move from the Grad Dinner to the auxiliary rink by 7:00 pm. Any students not attending the Grad Dinner please make sure you arrive by 7:00pm. Some students who are receiving awards or certificates will need to be at the auxiliary arena by 6:30 for photos. Not all students receiving awards will be on the list for photos. A list of those students having their photo taken will be posted at the school on Monday June 25th. Students attending Prom can check the list then. If not attending Prom please make arrangements to check the list before graduation.

AUXILLARY ARENA SET UP AND RULES: The Auxiliary Arena is where students arrange themselves in alphabetical order. Chairs are organized into two groups – alphabetically, with index cards bearing student’s name. Students should find the chair which has a file card attached to it with their name. Do not remove the index cards from the chair until just before marching time. When it is time to proceed to the Main Arena, students take their index card with them. The index card is passed to Ms. Denise Chiasson or Mr. Charles MacDonald at the podium where all the information on the card is read to the audience. Students receive a “fake” diploma on stage from Ms. Wanda Fougere and then receive the Official Diploma from Mrs. Leisa Brow AFTER crossing the stage.

RULES:
No cell phones please
Bathroom break BEFORE ceremony NOT DURING
Remember this is an official ceremony

ENVELOPES: The envelope you receive from Mrs. Leisa Brow will contain important information i.e. Official Diploma, Transcript of Marks (2 copies), and any awards you may receive. THE ENVELOPES MAY CONTAIN CHEQUES, SO BE VERY CAREFUL NOT TO LOSE THE ENVELOPE OR ITS CONTENTS.

Transcript: There are 2 copies – one student copy and the second copy MUST be sent to the Admissions Office at the school you are attending in September. This should be mailed immediately after graduation. DO NOT WAIT UNTIL SEPTEMBER!!

Diplomas: The NS Diploma you earn is an important document. It should be kept somewhere safe. Many organizations, grad schools, etc., often ask for copies of the Diploma for entrance into their programs.

Thank You Notes: Any student receiving an award is expected to write a thank you note to the person/organization which issued the award.

GOWN PICK-UP AND RETURN: Graduation gowns will arrive during the week of exams – an announcement will be made when they are available for pick up. Gowns must be returned at the end of the Graduation Ceremony – students will march back into the Auxiliary Arena where we will have a drop off location for the grad gowns. Any gowns not returned will cost the student approximately \$110.
